
- · R&D team SIDN



Hierarchy

- · 'root'
- Top-level domains
 .com .net .edu
 (and many more)
 - · .nl .be .uk
 - · (and many many more)
- · Second-level domains
 - · uvt.nl
 - · facebook.com
 - · (and over 200 million more)
- Many levels possible
- this.is.a.long.multilabel.domain.name.to.show.that.they.can.be.more.than.just.tjeb.nl





Country Code Top-Level Domains

- Must have ISO 3166 code (NL, BE, DE, etc)
- · Always two letters
- Delegated on behalf of government
 - But often to private parties





General Top-Level Domains

- · Not tied to geography
- · Always 3 or more letters
- · Open for registration at ICANN
 - \cdot But with a lot of rules






A Brief History of DNS

- But updated and extended ever since












A Brief History of DNS

- Initially, all top-level domains maintained by one person; Jon Postel
- ICANN was formed in 1998 under contract of the NTIA (part of the US DoC)
- · ICANN maintains zone
- · Verisign is technical partner
- Actual servers globally distributed

- · cwi.nl first .nl domain

- Delegation awarded to CWI in 1986
- · cwi.nl first .nl domain
- CWI maintained .nl
 Or really, Piet Beertema did manually
- Domain names free, but not available to everyone





- · SIDN formed in 1996
- · RRR-model put in place
- Needed KvK-number (Dutch Chamber of Commerce) to be eligable for a domain name
- · Domain names no longer free



RRR model

· SIDN does not 'sell' directly





- 'Personal domain names' introduced in 2000
- Had to be of the form jelte.123.nl
- \cdot Not much interest





- Registration opened up in 2003
- · But still with RRR model
- Personal Domain Names discontinued in 2006
 - \cdot Only about 500 of them





- .nl now one of the largest ccTLDs
- · 5.4 million domain names
- · 1800 registrars

- Register it

How to register a (.nl) domain name

- \cdot Check whether it is free
- · Register it
- \cdot At a registrar
- Yearly fee, automatically renewed





Becoming a registrar

- Any legal person in the EU, except private individuals
- \cdot One-time registration fee
- · Monthly fee





Registered Domain Names

- Belong to the registrant ('the domain holder')
- \cdot NOT the registrar
- Authority over changes belongs to the holder
- Including moving to other registrar





Registered Domain Names

- Registrar and registrant details available (through 'WHOIS')
- Full details only to other registrars
- Limited details to the general public
- Both have daily access limit





Protection of registered domains

- · DNSSEC
 - Cryptographic protection of DNS content
- · .nl Control
 - Protects against unwarranted changes to your domain

· DBS

- Detects typosquats similar to your domain (e.g. mybank-login.nl for mybank.nl)
- May also be legit, so we only notify





Conflicts


- Registrant have obligation not to infringe other's rights
- · SIDN does not censor
- · SIDN does not play police





Conflicts (the easy way)

- Low-barrier dispute resolution process, based on ICANN's UDRP
 - Register complaint (at WIPO)
 - · Domain is frozen
 - · SIDN first mediates
 - If mediation fails, Independent panelist decides






Conflicts (the easy way)

- Low-barrier dispute resolution process, based on ICANN's UDRP
 - Register complaint (at WIPO)
 - · Domain is frozen
 - · SIDN first mediates
 - If mediation fails, Independent panelist decides








Conflicts (the hard way)

- Either party can start a court procedure
- SIDN will then not implement panelist's decision
- · SIDN will await court's decision







Cause for complaints

- Name identical or confusingly similar to:
 - · Trademark under Dutch law
 - · Registered personal name

AND

 No legitimate interest in the name to registrant

AND

 Domain name registered in bad faith





Cause for complaints

- Bad faith when domain is registered:
 - for sole purpose of selling at a higher price OR
 - to deny others' use OR
 - to disrupt others' activity OR
 - · to confuse visitors





Cause for complaints

- · Derived from those rules:
 - Domain is not by itself a trademark violation
 - Domaining (reselling at higher price) is not necessarily done in bad faith






Some stats from 2013


- · 65 cases sent to WIPO
- · 33 went into mediation
- · 12 mediated succesfully
- 21 cases went through to resolution process
- \cdot 1 went to court after that

(mediation sucessrate in 2014 so far at 50%)





Other types of complaints

- · Fraud & Abuse
- · Generally not on the level of the domain itself
- · SIDN can't shut down a domain
- \cdot We either:
 - \cdot Refer to registrar
 - provide info (to specific parties, e.g. inspection for health care)
- Notice & Takedown last resort
